Homestead Exemption for Veterans with Disabilities **(PTAX-342) Checklist**

To file for the Disabled Veteran Exemption you must be a disabled veteran with a service-connected injury over 30% for the application year or on a prorated basis during the time of occupancy.

70%-100% - if the EAV is less than 250,000 you will have no tax liability, a zero tax bill. If your assessed value is over 250,000, you will be taxed on the difference. If your disability is marked total and permanent on your VA verification letter, you may not have to renew every year.

50%-60% the annual reduction is 5,000 off the assessed value

30%-40% the annual reduction is 2,500 off the assessed value.

Please submit copies of the following documents along with your first time Disabled Veterans' Application:

- Current disability certification letter from the US Dept of Veterans' affairs. It must state that your injury is service connected and your percentage.
- DD 214
